OF THE 421 YOUTH WHO WERE MATCHED WITH A MENTOR IN 2019, 100% SHOWED A POSITIVE SENSE OF SELF-CONFIDENCE AND 100% FELT ABLE TO MAKE GOOD, STRONG DECISIONS. 100% OF THE YOUTH WHO WERE IN MENTORING RELATIONSHIPS HAD NO CONTACT WITH JUVENILE COURT. IN ADDITION TO THESE BEHAVIORAL OUTCOMES, WE SEE SIGNIFICANT EDUCATIONAL GAINS IN OUR MENTORED YOUTH. 50% OF THESE YOUTH HAVE IMPROVED ACADEMICALLY WITH 100% BEING PROMOTED TO THE NEXT GRADE. 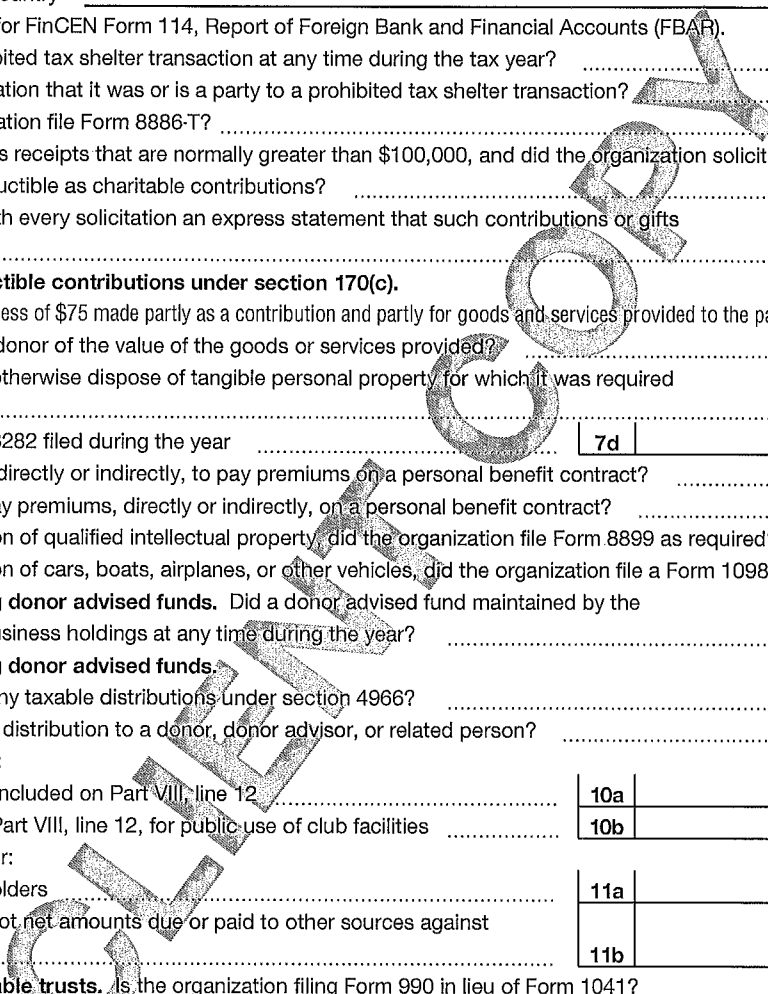

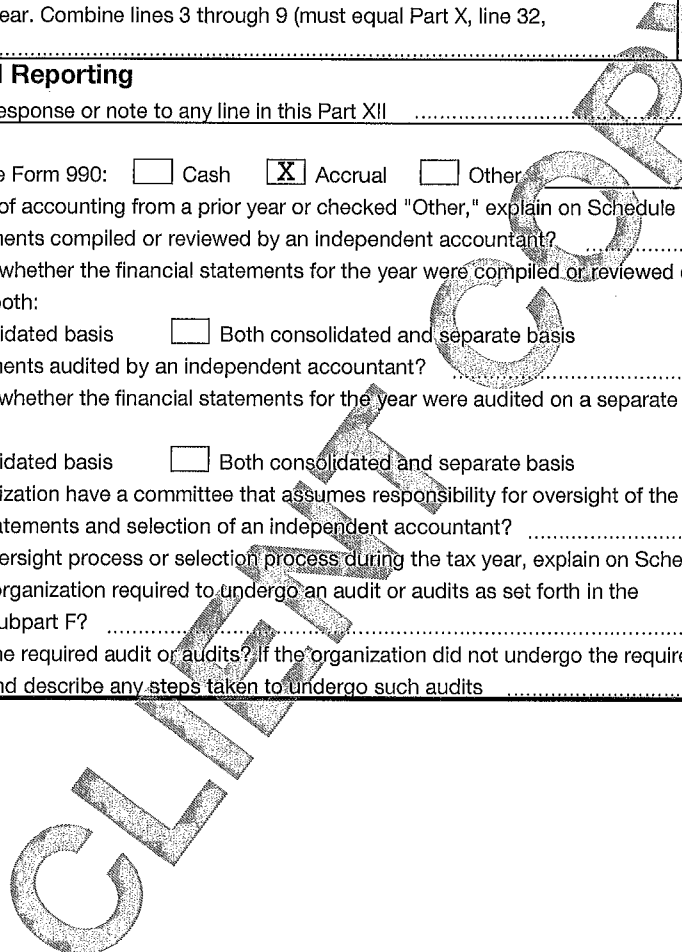

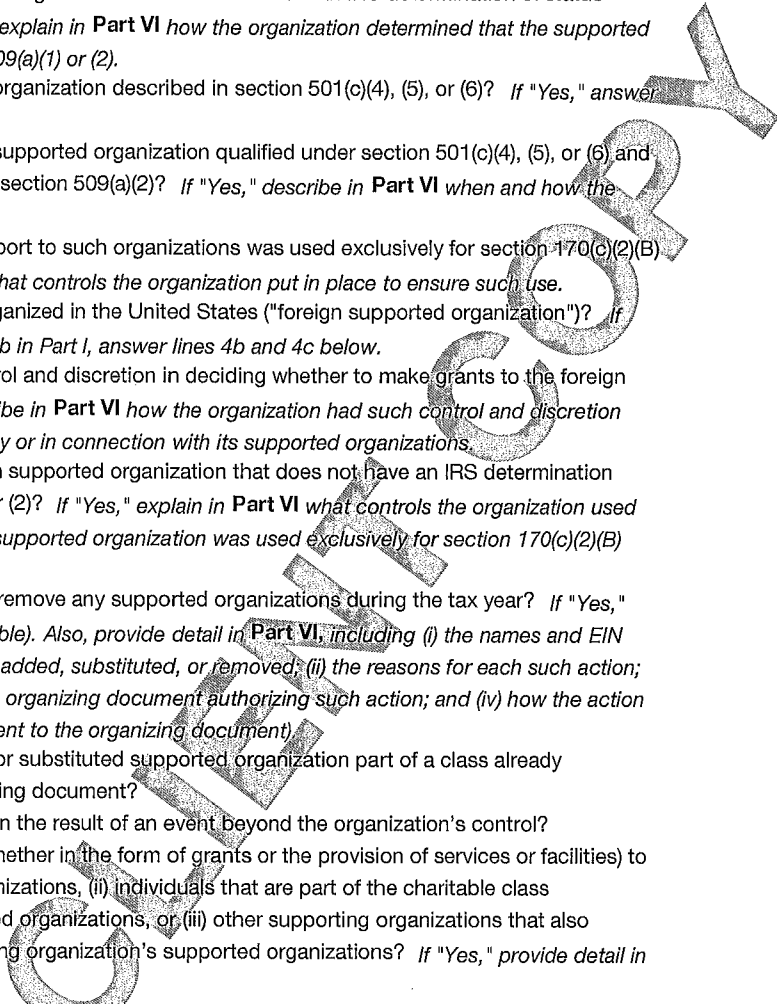
